# WHY IT'S REQUIRED

Schools, recruiters and employment agencies in China want to see you, hear your accent, and get a feel for your personality before inviting you for an interview. Unfortunately, they're not going to meet you in person before you arrive!

#### WHERE IT'S GOING 02

### WHAT TO WEAR 03

There's no requirement to dress up smart. You can wear casual clothes if you'd prefer, but remember, you are giving off a first impression to a potential employer!

## HOW TO FILM 04

A smartphone or computer webcam video is sufficient. Selfie-style is also okay if you prefer this. Keep it between 30-90 seconds.

# WHAT TO SAY

Try sticking to a script like this:

- Hello, my name is ...
- I'm from ...
- I studied ... at university
- [Discuss teaching/relevant experience]
- I'd love to move to [China] because ...

## ANY TIPS? 06

Be you! And try and keep the file under 10MB if you can - there are various sites online where you can compress this for free. This makes it much easier to share.
